- Roads & Bridges: \$4.5 billion for federal-aid highway apportioned programs, \$302 million for bridges.
- **Public Transit:** About \$818 million to improve our public transportation
- **Electric Vehicles:** About \$68 million for an electric vehicle charging network.
- Internet Access: about \$100 million Airports: About \$297 million
- Water and Waste Water: \$680 million over five years to improve water infrastructure
